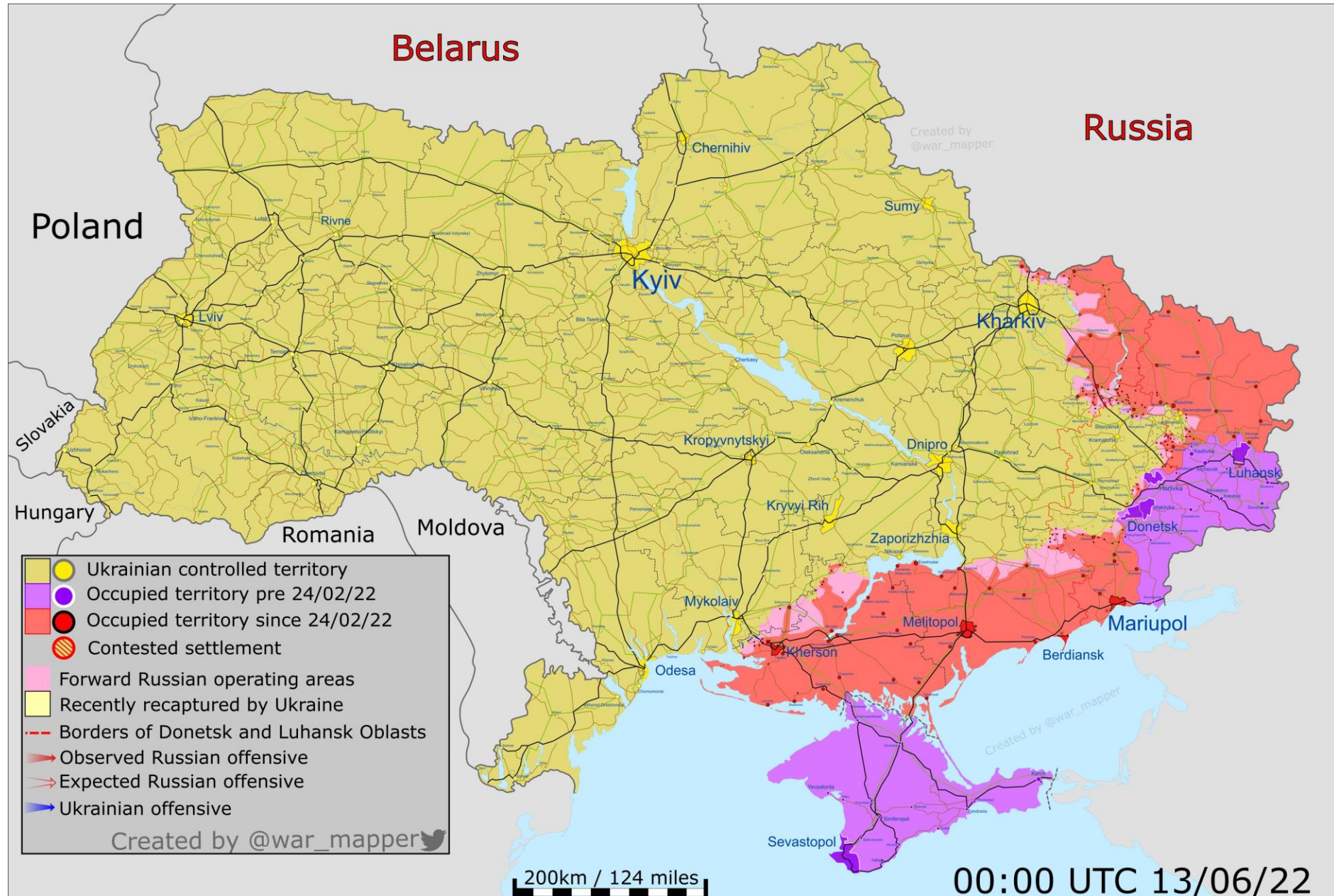

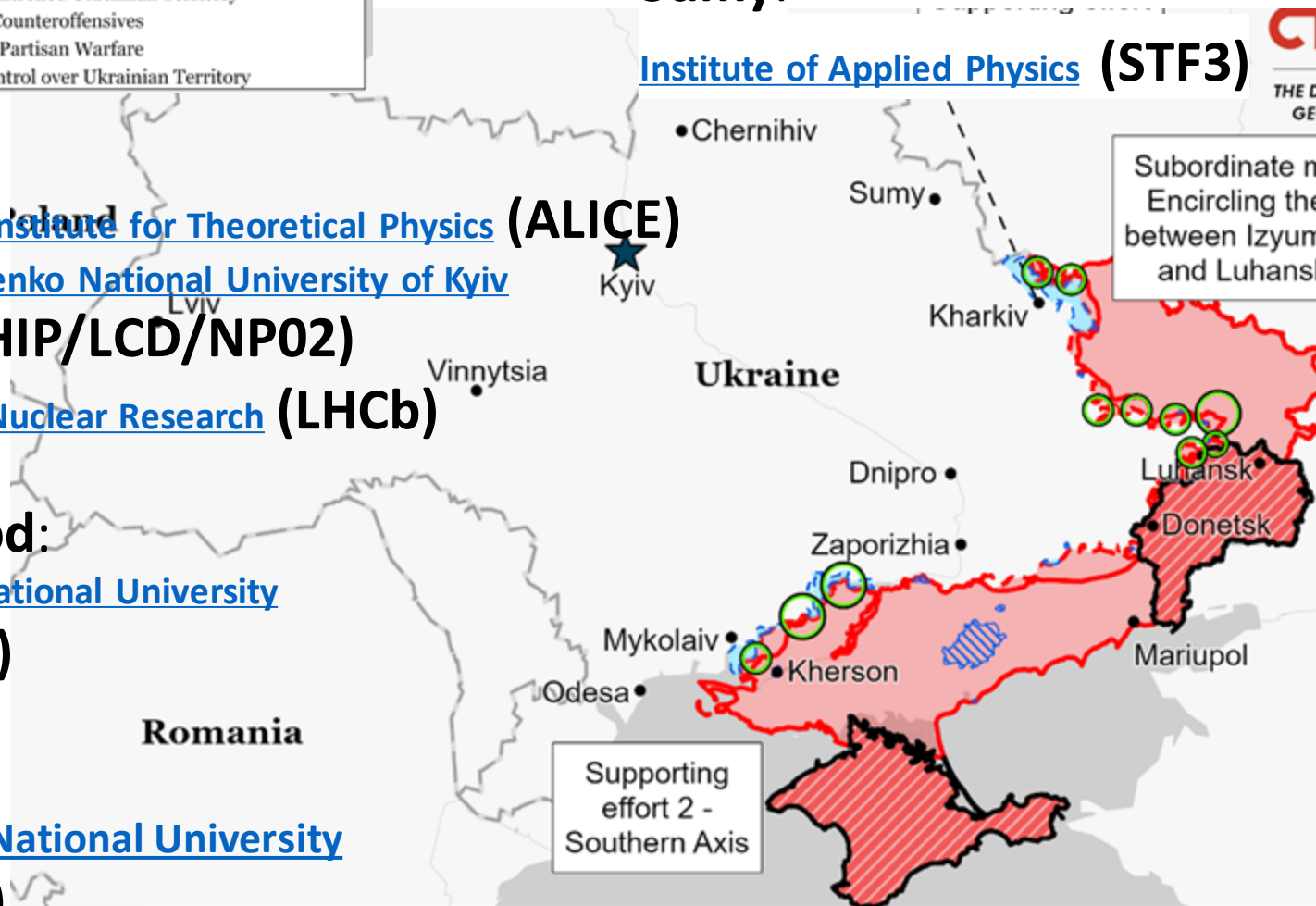

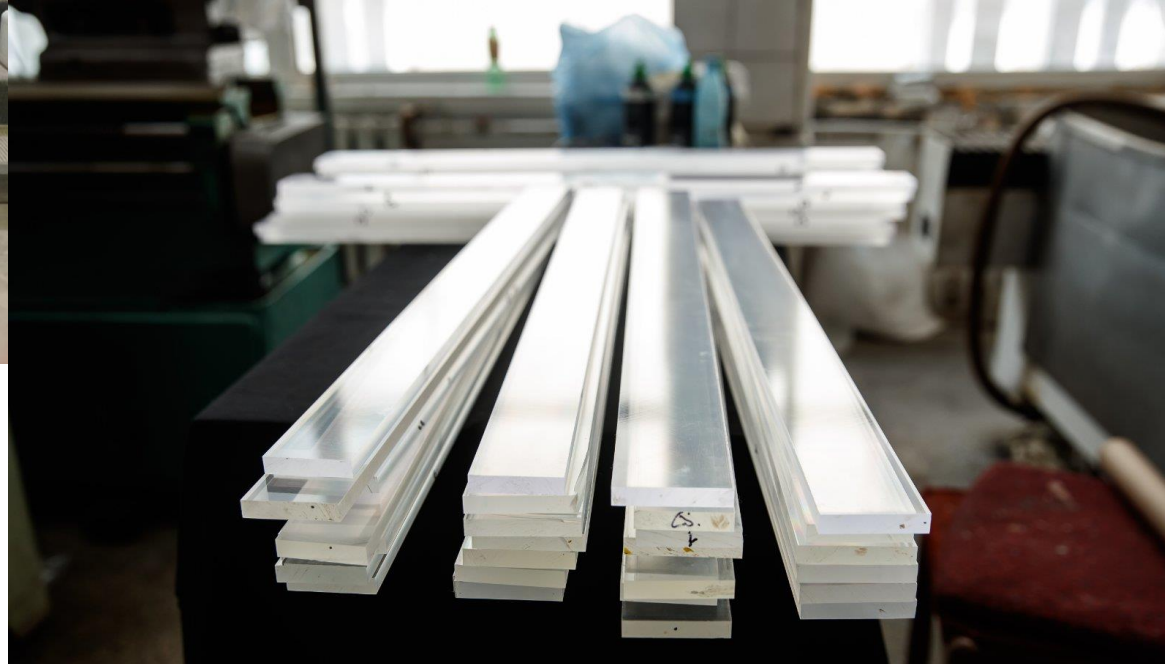

Dear Prof. Buzatu,

Due to the war unleashed by the Russian Federation in Ukraine, my country can no longer be a member of an international scientific organization that stands apart from this situation and whose headquarters is located on the territory of the aggressor-country.

Therefore, in my letter dated 05/18/2022 reference number 1/17-2-8, which was sent to the Director of the Joint Institute for Nuclear Research (hereinafter – the JINR) and to you, as the Chairman of the Committee of Plenipotentiaries of the Governments of JINR Member States, I informed about the process of Ukraine's withdrawal from JINR.

I received the Protocol of the session of the Committee of Plenipotentiaries of the Governments of the Member States of the JINR that was held on 25<sup>th</sup> of May 2022. In paragraphs 5 and 8 of the Protocol the Committee of Plenipotentiaries noted of the statements of the Slovak Republic and Romania, respectively, on suspension of their collaboration with JINR.

To my surprise, I did not see on the agenda the consideration of the issue of Ukraine's withdrawal from JINR. Unfortunately, the JINR directorate ignores my letters of appeal in every possible way. This situation at the Committee of Plenipotentiaries of the Governments of JINR Member States is a confirmation of this.

I ask you to assist in resolving the issue of Ukraine's withdrawal from JINR.
