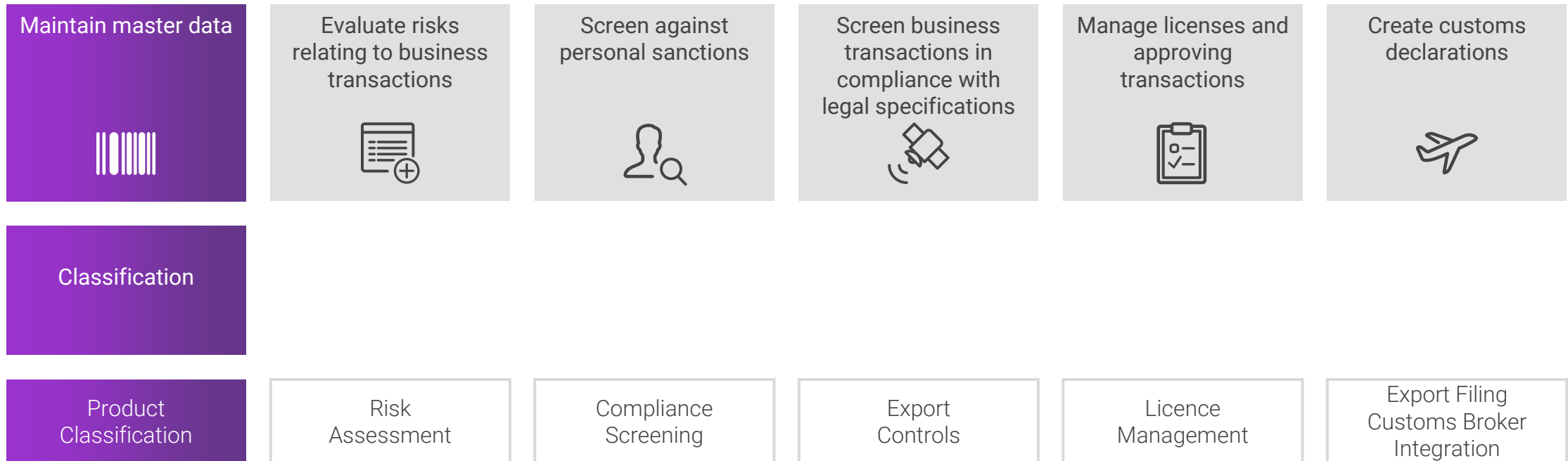

Determining relevant sections, chapters, headings

No guarantee of internationally uniform classification

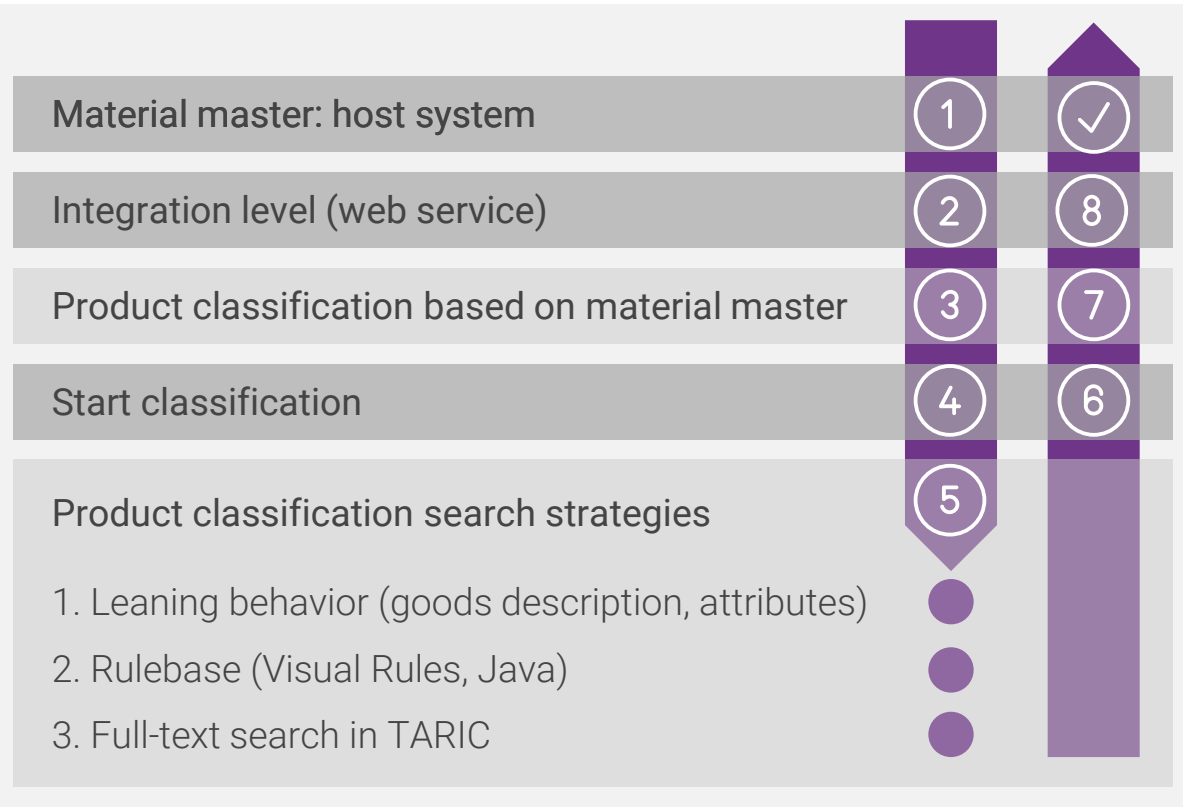

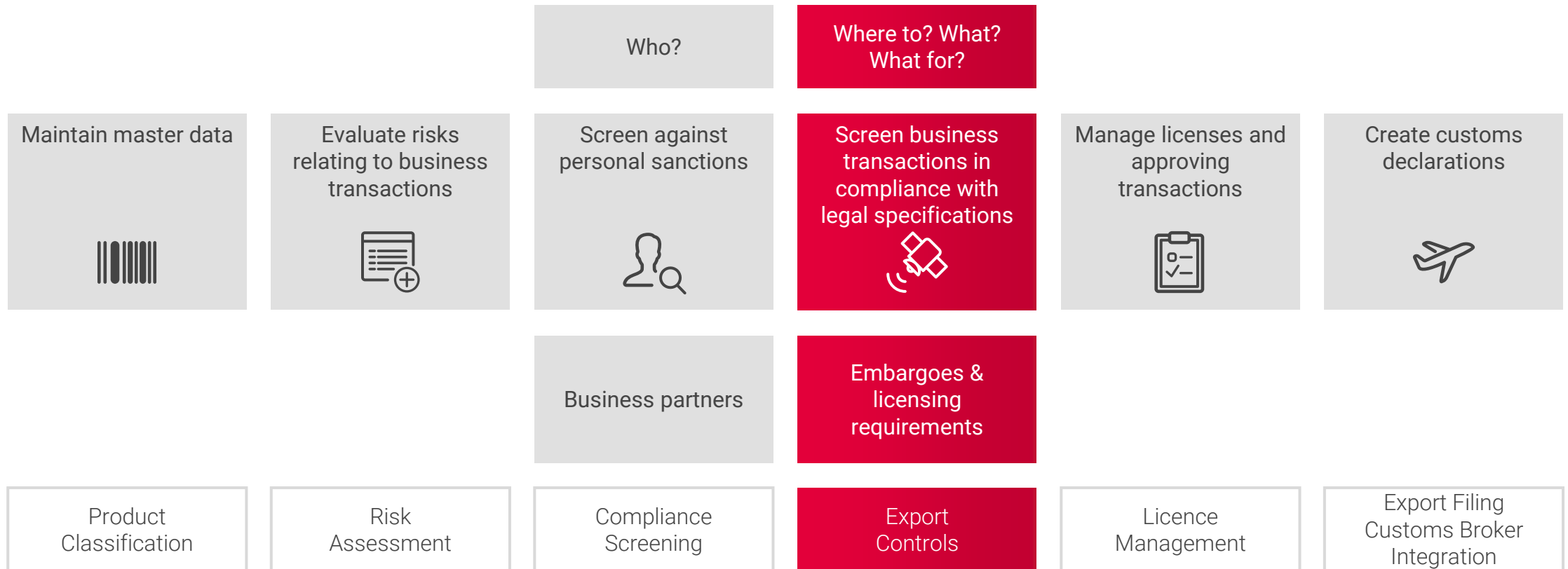

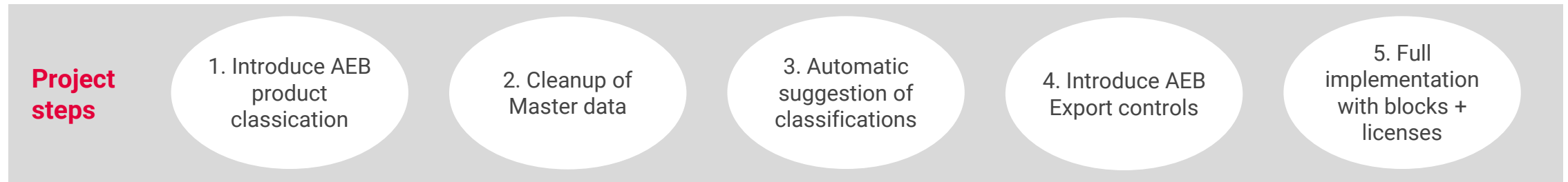

EU

- License required under EU law to export goods listed in Annex I of the EU Dual-Use Regulation pursuant to Art. 3 (1) of the Regulation.
- The "EU" general license "EU001" may be applicable. Please check the conditions regarding goods, destination, requirements, and additional conditions.

US EAR

- License required for the country "CH" based on the reason for control "RS1" for parts of the US export control number
- License required for the country "CH" based on the reason for control "MT1" for parts of the US export control number
- License exception "GOV" may be applicable. Please check the conditions regarding goods, destination, requirements, and additional conditions.
- License exception "LVS" may be applicable. This is not certain, however, because the material classification is ambiguous.
